## THE FUTURE IS NOW

It always amazes me how history repeats itself again and again. I was recently reading an article by Dr. Thurman Fleet that he wrote for a 1961 Beamer Magazine where he was discussing the "new" advertising plan. As a matter of fact one of his statements was "Every penny of the X Fund to be spent for Advertising". I have been involved in every advertising program that the Institute has attempted in the past 35 years and no matter what method we used we still had the same problem that Dr. Fleet encountered back in the 60's. That problem is the only way you can "sell" Concept-Therapy is on a personal basis. We have tried advertisements in major national magazines, television commercials, newspaper articles and with the advent of the world wide web, mass emailings. And the result is the same as it was for Dr. Fleet back in the 40's, 50's, 60's and 70's...Concept-Therapy can best be sold to another by a dedicated Beamer who feels he or she has found something worthwhile to share with their friends and neighbors.

In the late 1970's Dr. Conrad O. Schenk, former President of the Concept-Therapy Institute tried to start a program he called the E.B.A.T. program (Every Beamer A Teacher). His program, like all the advertising and promotion programs, met with limited success. The reason for the EBAT program's failure was due to the fact that it was difficult for Beamers to explain Concept-Therapy to their friends and neighbors. After one has taken their first courses in CT you want to tell everyone about it, don't you? But what do you say? Beamers, we finally have an answer for you that you will not only like but it will be the "missing link" between you and sharing the truth of Concept-Therapy with others. That missing link is the new Virtual Concept-Therapy Program which you will be able to share with others in the comfort of your own home. This program (either a 21 hour version or a 14 hour version) was filmed in high definition perfect for your television. This seminar will be made available to Beamers upon request, for you to be able to share CT with your friends and neighbors. You can choose the format of your liking. Either hold the entire class in one weekend, split it into two weekends, show it once a week for 2-3 hours per night for either six weeks or seven weeks depending upon the class you choose, or any format that fits your schedule.

The details will be forthcoming to you as the program becomes fully developed. If you should decide to participate in this program you would be known as a Class Facilitator and you would receive a percentage of the class tuition in payment for holding the class in your home. You will be given complete instructions for not only playing the videos but for discussing the chapters viewed in conjunction with a Facilitators/Students workbook.

Not only will we supply you with professionally filmed DVD's that will promote the class, we will also provide videos imbedded in emails that you can use to advertise the Virtual Class. If you wanted to hold a meeting in your home to interest your friends and neighbors we would supply you with all the information you would need to get them to take the course.

Your choice of classes will be from our most experienced and dedicated instructors. The Mattox Team (Char and Emily) teach the 21 hour version and myself, Bill McKeown, Dr. Peter Goldman, Dr. Mike Fitzgerald and Dr. Rhea Zimmerman teach the 14 hour seminar. At the present time you can go to our website and view video snippets from the class by clicking on the left side of the Home Page under titles that read "What do you want?"; "Concepts to change your world"; "Image of Creation""Beam Club" and "Concept-Therapy Overview".

This is the most exciting and ambitious program that the Institute has undertaken in many years and we hope that you will choose to be a part of our future. Concept-Therapy is needed drastically by the world and with the Virtual Concept-Therapy Seminar we can now make it available to those who want to not only understand this world but to actually live a better life. ### Concept-Therapy...Programming for the Future

Is Concept-Therapy getting better? What kind of question is that, considering all the wonderful pioneer teachers we have had in the past? And better in what way, we might also ask? The answer is certainly not that the texts are better, because they contain the

same wonderful principles they always have; and the answer is not that we have better teachers now than we had in the early days, because we have always had dedicated, committed, and loyal teachers. The reason for that bold statement is twofold: 1) better tools to work with; and 2) an unimaginably larger potential for getting this marvelous correlation of the Truths of the Ages out to a suffering world than what was available before the present time.

How Dr. Fleet would have loved these tools that we have to work with now! He was excited with reel-to-reel tape recorders, 16mm movies, and film strips, and he predicted that one day this work could be taught through the use of multimedia that still had not been invented during his lifetime. Television was available during his time with us, and main frame computers, but the personal computer was still only an image in the minds of a few electronic pioneers, much less the Internet and all the possibilities that venue opens up. Dr. Fleet eagerly used whatever technology was available at the time such as showing a 16mm film on genetics at the first Phase 5 in Chicago and a filmstrip on de Chardin's "Phenomenom of Man" at the first Phase 7 class in Dallas. At this class he foretold how the class of the future would be conducted, and announced that soon people would be watching Concept-Therapy classes on their televisions world-wide. The television remote was a miracle of invention to him, and he never tired of examining it's possibilities.

Now we have digital video and audio equipment that is capable of capturing and storing classes on CDs, DVDs and on the Internet so they can be distributed world-wide. We have added movie clips, special effects, and power-point presentations to our lectures so we are on par with modern communication practices. We are streaming live classes on the Internet so that they are available everywhere in the world in real time. For the first time in history, Dr. Fleet's dream of this philosophy spreading all over the world is manifesting as never before. Just look at the flags on "The Beamer" header!

CTI is also pulling out all the stops for getting our work to the public. Warren McKenney, backed by our President George T. Fleet Jr, has developed the idea of Virtual CT classes that are pre-recorded with all the bells and whistles available now, and that can be facilitated by Beamers everywhere. This will enable all those Beamers over the years to facilitate classes where they may have been hesitant to handle all the details required by a traditional class. In addition, Warren is embarking on a grand new venture of taking this work to corporations and educational institutions to make it a part of their corporate and educational culture.

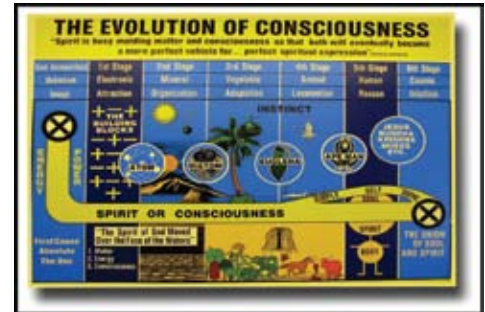

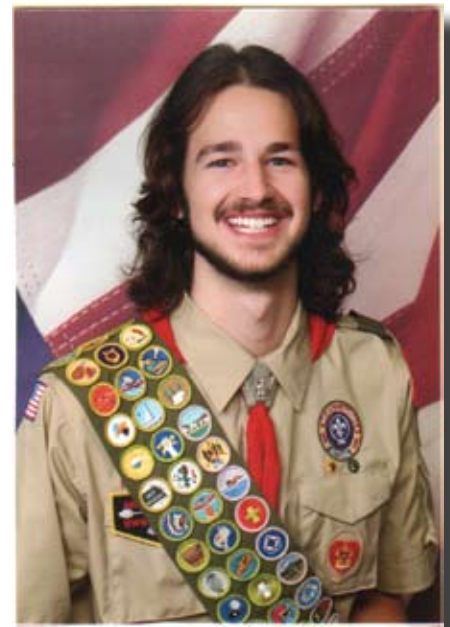

## Eagle Scout Joins Kin in Rarefied Air

Aaron Schulze had a lot to live up to after joining the Boy Scouts at age 6. Schulze's brothers both became Eagle Scouts, the highest rank in Scouting. His oldest brother, David, now 25, had earned all 125 merit badges by 2004, a rare achievement. His other brother, Lance, now 22, did the same in 2007.

"After joining Boy Scouts, I got to watch David at his Eagle Scout ceremony," Schulze said. "I admired how he was honored and decided I wanted to do the same."

With help from his brothers, Schulze set off to continue the tradition.

"I wanted to be just like them," Schulze said. "I thought I would be so cool."

Now an Eagle Scout himself, Schulze recently achieved his dream of earning all available badges - 129 in his case. Schulz, 18, got four extra badges available only this year, for the 100th anniversary of Scouting.

"I will always be able to look at my brothers and say, 'I have more badges than you do,'" Schulze said Saturday during an Eagle Court of Honor at St. George Episcopal Church, to acknowledge his achievements.

The four extra badges are for carpentry, pathfinding, signaling, and tracking. Schulze's other badges include a six-month bird study, more than 50 miles of cycling, and scuba diving, which took about 50 hours of instruction, said his father, Randall Schulze. According to a bulletin from the Scouts, only 129 Scouts in the history of Scouting have achieved this level.

The Schulz brothers are also third generation Beavers with parents and grandparents going all the way back to the very first Concept-Therapy class taught by Dr. Fleet.

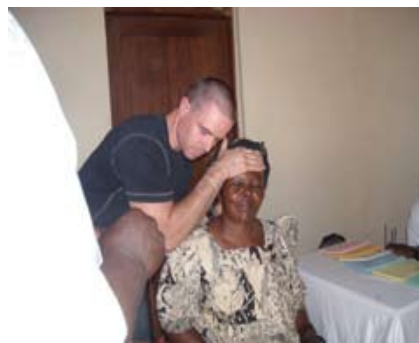
## DR. GOLMAN GOES TO AFRICA TO PROVIDE ZONE HEALING
